Buttock Fat Grafting/BBL Post Operative Care Instructions

Rest + Relaxation

- Sleep in the positions that were discussed prior to your surgery (chest only, chest and side only, or chest and back only) for 4-6 weeks.
- Avoid pressure on the areas where fat was placed.
- You may wish to cover your mattress with a plastic sheet/garbage bags as you may have fluid that leaks out of the surgical puncture sites for a few days.
- The fluid is often blood tinged and the amount will decrease over a few days
- Sitting is permitted for a short periods of time (less than 15 minutes) during the first 3 weeks after surgery. Preferably use a memory foam pillow.
- Wait 1 week before participating in physical activities that will increase your heart rate and blood pressure

Washing

- Remove larger dressings 24 hours after surgery.
- You will notice bruising and swelling to the areas which have been operated on.
- Leave your steri-strips (white tape) in place for 5 to 7 days or until they fall off.
- You can shower 24 hours after surgery.
- Do not soak your surgical sites - no pools, hot tubs, or lake water for 3 weeks.
- Dry surgical site by gently patting with a clean towel or allow to air dry.

Medication

- Anti-Pain medication can be taken after surgery.
- Resume prescribed medications unless otherwise stated.
- Take antibiotics as prescribed at the appropriate times until completed.
- Apply Polysporin (original ointment) to your incision lines 1 x a day once steri-strips are removed.

Garment Wear

- Wear your compression garments 20/24 hrs for 4 -6 weeks.
- When removing your compression garments for the first few times, do so while lying down to avoid feeling faint
- Swelling will subside naturally over weeks to months and your garments will help minimize this time.

Massage

- Start to massage any areas where liposuction was performed as soon as possible to soften the tissue
- You may wish to seek out a massage therapist or one who specializes in lymphatic drainage techniques **Two**

Weeks After Surgery

- Begin to massage your incisions with body lotion, BioOil, or equivalent scar cream. Do not use 100% vitamin E (capsule or oil).
- If your incisions are going to be exposed to the sun, apply SPF 45 or higher for at least one year to prevent tanning.

Follow Up Care

A post-operative appointment will be made for you on your surgical date.
